

2 PILLARS TO FIGHT AGAINST FOOD FRAUD: INVESTIGATION & PREVENTION

INVESTIGATION

Lead: Danone Security department

What: unique asset to support investigations conducted by official national / international organizations/agencies to dismantle the network of organized crimes and feed our system by enriching the control measure to be put in place.

PREVENTION

Lead: Danone Food Safety department + Quality organization

What: identifying, addressing and mitigating major food fraud vulnerabilities. Crossfunctional involvement as a key success factor. More in next slides.

A clear aim: Protection & Compliance




Prioritization of major vulnerabilities to be addressed (≠ an endless wish list)

ASSESSING FOOD FRAUD VULNERABILITIES

AS INTEGRATED PROCESS IN THE FOOD SAFETY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

Food Fraud Vulnerability:

It literally means a weakness or flaw that creates opportunities for undesirable events.

In context of food fraud, vulnerability refers to our company exposure to fraudulent activities.



→ Key factors do determine or influence a company's vulnerability to food fraud.





A multi-disciplinary assessment

Covering full value chain, including upstream and downstream

ASSESSING FOOD FRAUD VULNERABILITIES

AS INTEGRATED PROCESS IN THE FOOD SAFETY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

Local

At Danone all business units are required to:



- establish a food fraud mitigation team
- perform a yearly food fraud vulnerability assessment (FFVA)
- implement a food fraud mitigation plan
- escalate vulnerabilities which require a global or regional assessment and mitigation approach.

Global




Each Division is coordinating the following topics:

- annual creation/ revision of a divisional food fraud risk map prioritizing the highest risks
- linking with enterprise risk management
- developing mitigation strategies/ solutions for prioritized risks
- supporting the local teams with expertise, mitigation, tools and training

=> FF Prevention Process integrated in the company's FSMS/ PDCA
